Additional Patient Care Advice

Blepharoplasty

Following your planned discharge, please ensure the following are adhered to, in order to optimise the healing process, unless otherwise instructed to by VVR:

For the 48 hours post-op
Ensure normal healthy diet with limited chewing
For the 2 weeks post-op:
Avoid stooping / bending
Bend knees, keeping back straight when lowering body
Sit / sleep propped upright when resting / sleeping
Showering – gently wash face / hair by standing in shower
Gently pat dry face with clean towel
Avoid pulling on stitches and tapes
Brushing teeth – stand in upright position - Rinse into cup
Do not drive until stitches are removed
Do not undertake any strenuous activity that raises the heart rate
(including housework) – maintain gentle mobility
Do not wear eye make-up for 2 weeks
It is anticipated that stitches and tapes, or glue if used to seal the
wound, will be removed during the follow-up meeting 1 week post-op
Timeframes on returning work / resuming normal activities will be re-
confirmed once reviews have taken place
