Additional Patient Care Advice

Breast Augmentation

Following your planned discharge, please ensure the following are adhered to, in order to optimise the healing process, unless otherwise instructed to by VVR

Absolute rest for 2 weeks – caring for yourself only
A 2 - 4 week recovery period is expected
Sit and sleep propped upright (advice -extra pillows)
No lifting, stretching, pulling or pushing – keeping arms close to body e.g
no housework or lifting children
No driving for 2 weeks
Supplied supportive bra to be worn for 6 weeks day and night – remove
only when showering
Use your usual non scented shower gel / soap, wash yourself including
your breasts and surgical glue.
Pat dry with clean towel, moisturise all breast area, reapply bra.
It is expected that you will attend a follow-up appointment after 1 week
post operation for check-up with a nurse
It is anticipated that during a follow-up appointment 2 nd week post
operation with VVR, breast examined and surgical glue removed and
advice provided.
Continue wearing bra
No driving
Sit / sleep propped upright when resting / sleeping
Showering – continue to wash / pat dry / moisturise breasts gently,
reapply bra
Continue to not undertake any strenuous upper body activity including
housework – maintain gentle mobility
It is anticipated a follow-up consultation with VVR is carried 4 weeks
post-op

	It may be advised that gentle increased activities may occur
6 weeks post- op:	
	Hospital supportive bra is replaced by a patients sports bra
	No bra's with underwire to be worn for 12 weeks
	It is anticipated that normal activity is resumed, including swimming and gym work

	confirmed once reviews have taken place
